Update on Water Authority Relocation of Water Lines Ahead Of Construction of Rio Grande/Candelaria Roundabout As of March 15, 2019

The intersection of Candelaria and Rio Grande closure has been extended through **Tuesday, April 9, 2019** due to the weather and unforeseen circumstances. **Additional partial closures of the intersection will be required after that time through late April to early May.**

Crews will be working this Saturday, March 16, from about 7 a.m. to about 5 p.m. to catch up.

Planned Construction through the end of March

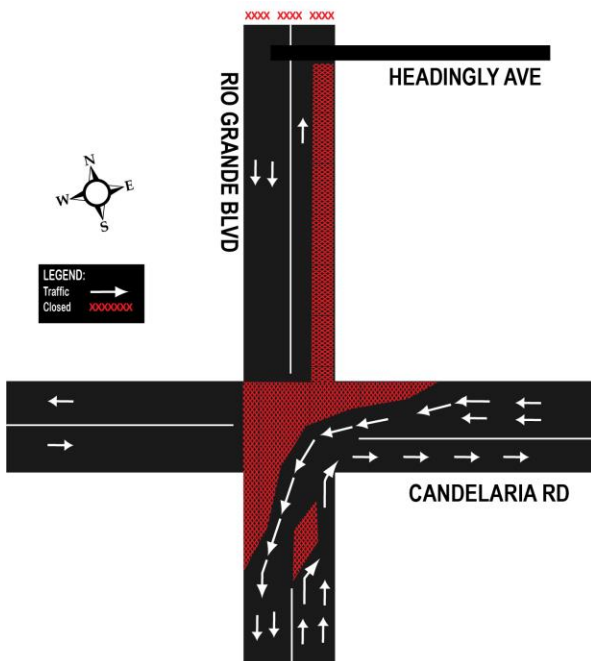
- Crews will be continuing relocation and installation of a new 24-inch waterline in the intersection.
- Crews will fill and test the new 12-inch waterline.
- Crews will be tying in the new 6-inch, 12-inch and 24-inch waterlines.
- If schedule allows, crews may begin removing old waterlines
- At the end of the month, crews will begin preparing the roadway with installation of new base course, to be followed by paving and striping in early April.

There are **NO planned water shutoffs** for the remainder of March.

Traffic Control

The current barricades will remain in place. **PLEASE NOTE IT IS AGAINST THE LAW TO MOVE BARRICADES.** Individuals who move barricades can face criminal penalties and fines.

The intersection of Rio Grande and Candelaria remains mostly closed.



1. Northbound traffic on Rio Grande can turn right and head east on Candelaria.
2. Westbound traffic on Candelaria can turn left and head south on Rio Grande.
3. Also, barricades have been added on Rio Grande north of Headingly to prevent cars traveling southbound on Rio Grande from being able to turn left onto Headingly and to prevent cars traveling west on Headingly from turning north (right) on Rio Grande.

The official detour is
12th Street and Griegos.

Regular work hours are
Monday-Friday, 7 a.m.-7 p.m., although crews may work longer hours or on Saturday if needed.
