Water Authority to Relocate Three Water Lines Ahead of Construction of Rio Grande/Candelaria Roundabout

Intersection of Rio Grande and Candelaria to Be Impacted From Feb. 22, 2019, through early May 2019




IMPORTANT UPDATE: Barring unforeseen circumstances, the contractor plans to finish work requiring a total closure of the Rio Grande/Candelaria intersection in about six weeks (by April 5, 2019). Work after that will require partial closures of the intersection.

Beginning **Friday, Feb. 22, 2019**, and lasting through **early May 2019**, Water Authority contractors will be relocating three water lines that must be moved to accommodate upcoming construction of the Rio Grande/Candelaria Roundabout. Century Link and Comcast will also be moving their lines during this time. Anyone affected by planned water outages will be notified in advance.

Traffic impacts are detailed below; lane closures are indicated in **RED** on the maps provided. *Please note that construction schedules are subject to change without notice. Also, the contractor will fully close the intersection for safety if needed.*

- 1) **Traffic heading west on Candelaria will be allowed to turn left and head south on Rio Grande**, but will **NOT** be allowed to turn right and head north on Rio Grande or continue west on Candelaria.
- 2) **Eastbound Candelaria will CLOSED at the intersection with Rio Grande.** Traffic will not be able to head north or south on Rio Grande or continue east on Candelaria.



- 3) **Traffic heading north on Rio Grande will be allowed to turn right and head east on Candelaria**, but will **NOT** be allowed to turn left and head west on Candelaria or continue north on Rio Grande.
- 4) **Southbound Rio Grande will CLOSED at the intersection with Candelaria.** Traffic will not be able to head east or west on Candelaria or continue south on Rio Grande.
- 5) **The designated detour for traffic will be 12th Street and Griegos Road.**

Crews will usually be working from **7 a.m.-7 p.m., Monday-Friday**, although they may work Saturdays or different hours if needed.
